FLIGHTS

DRUG TESTING

Athletes who compete in the Australian University Games may be subject to 'Doping Control' (more commonly known as drug testing).

AUS strongly suggests that athletes take the opportunity to complete the Australian Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) education program so they are aware of their rights and proper practices for Doping Control.

The ASADA Education and general websites have an excellent level of information. The links are:

One inescapable aspect to anti-doping is that the obligation is on the athlete to be aware of what they 'put into your body'.
